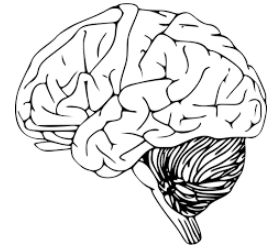


# Research Study: Mental Health in Cornelia de Lange Syndrome
